Background and Purpose

Award and Presentation

Ashland County 4-H Committee will be awarding one-time minimum \$500 scholarship.

Depending on number of applicants, numerous awards maybe given.

A panel of judges will make the selection. Application will be assigned a number not by name.

++ Scholarship winner (s) will receive award at their school Sr. awards assembly.

++ Name and picture displayed in the Jr. Fair building at Ashland County fair.

++ Winners introduced at the fundraising dinner November 2023.

You and your parents will attend as our quests (3 tickets).

++ Winners introduced at the 4-H awards Banquet 2023.

MONEY dispersed to student after 4-H scholarship chairman or Ashland County 4-H office receive 1st quarter grade transcript from attending college or trade school office.

****Note:** May 1st 2024 deadline to redeem. After this date scholarship will be forfeited.)

Selection Procedure and Criteria

1. Current active Ashland County 4-H member taking projects and being enrolled at least 3 consecutive years 2022, 2021, 2020 and taken project (verified by Extension office.)

2. Current High School Senior

Student to be enrolled in an accredited college, field of study not limited, student attend College / or Trade school this fall 2023.

To apply for scholarship: Applicant must complete an Ashland County 4-H Committee Scholarship Application form and attach the following items for reference purposes:

1. A current HS grade transcript with official seal. (grades not a basis for scholarship selection)
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation. (**no** family member may be used)
 - a. One (1) from 4-H Advisor or 4-H Committee member
 - b. One (1) from Teacher, Academic Advisor, Guidance Counselor, Employer, minister or other community leader.
3. c. Narrative 4-H Story ---- that shares how:
“4-H Contributed to Your personal development” Leadership skills, and Career plans
--one page double spaced
4. d. Describe
“Your Educational plan and field of study and designated occupation”.
