WHEN: Ohio 4-H “season” begins in January/February. You may join a club at any time, but join by April 15 to be able to take advantage of all 4-H opportunities and be eligible to show at the county fair.

WHERE: There are over 35 4-H clubs located throughout Ashland County. See the back for a list and contact information.

COST: Most project books cost \$6 with additional costs for project supplies. Some 4-H Clubs may collect nominal dues to support activities.

AGE: Participants must be at least 8 years old and be in the third grade by 1/1/20. All youth age 9 as of 1/1/20 are eligible regardless of grade.

Please note that some 4-H clubs offer the Cloverbud program for youth age 5 and in kindergarten to second grade as of 1/1/20.
