WHEN: Ohio 4-H “season” begins in January/February. You may join a club at any time, but **join by April 15 at v2.4honline.com** to be able to take advantage of all 4-H opportunities and be eligible to show at the county fair.

WHERE: There are over 35 4-H clubs located throughout Ashland County. See the back for a list and contact information.

COST: Most project books cost **\$8** with additional costs for project supplies. Some 4-H Clubs may collect nominal dues to support activities.

AGE: Participants must be at least 8 years old and be in the third grade by **January 1**. All youth age 9 as of **January 1** are eligible regardless of grade.

Please note that some 4-H clubs offer the Cloverbud program for youth age 5 and in kindergarten to second grade as of **January 1**.
