## Possession Deadline for 4-H Animals is June 1

Just a reminder that all 4-H animals must be in the possession of the 4-H/FFA member by June 1.

Market rabbits and market chickens are the exception to this rule.

- **Market goats** will be weighed in and tagged on June 1 at the fairgrounds. See farther down in newsletter for details.
- **Market lambs** will be tagged on Saturday, June 5 at the fairgrounds. See farther down in newsletter for details.
- **Swine:** Come to the Extension Office to pick up your ID tag and forms. Hog must be tagged and forms turned into the Extension Office by Friday, June 4 at 3pm.
- **Feeder Calves:** Come to the Extension Office to pick up your ID tag and form. Form must be turned into the Extension Office by June 1.

### 2021 Market Chicken Essay Contest

**Due to Extension Office by Friday, June 25**

The 4-H Poultry Committee is sponsoring an essay contest for all youth who would like to take market chickens this year at the fair. The youth must agree to join 4-H this year and use the market chickens as a 4-H project. The entry should consist of a cover page with name, address, phone number, age, name of 4-H group and a signed statement of parental approval. The essay should be a minimum of one page with no identifying names and include the following general topics:

- What goals the member will set for project?
- How will the animal be cared for?
- What housing facilities are available for the animal?

**Up to 15 chicks** will be awarded to the winner! Essay entrants should pay for their birds and, if selected as the winner, will be reimbursed by the committee.

## Goat Tagging and Weigh-In

**All market goats MUST have goats tagged and weighed in on June 1, 2021 at the Fairgrounds.** Members with last names starting with A-K from 6:30-7:15 pm, last names starting with L-Z from 7:15-8 pm.

Dehorning and banding or castration must be done prior to tagging/weigh-in or the goat will be ineligible. Horns are allowed per breed standards on all meat goat breeds, angoras and pygmies. All dairy goats, including market dairy goats, shall not have horns.

Each member may tag up to 4 meat market goats and up to 4 dairy market goats in June. The first two in each category will be free. The third and fourth goat will be \$3 each

**Any Exhibitor bringing a Lamancha Goat as their market project please be aware of the new tagging requirement.**

Each Lamancha Market project will be required to bring the scrapies tag for that animal to the June 1st tagging/weigh in day. The Goat Committee will provide a collar that will be attached with the scrapies tag and market tag, which the goat committee provides. The Goat Committee will provide the collar this year only. The exhibitor will be required to provide the collar and scrapies tag themselves starting next year for each Lamancha Goat market project. If the exhibitor does not provide their own collar the Goat Committee will have collars available to purchase. If there are any questions, please contact someone on the Goat Committee.
