2021 Market Chicken Essay Contest


Due to Extension Office by Friday, June 25


The 4-H Poultry Committee is sponsoring an essay contest for all youth who would like to take market chickens this year at the fair. The youth must agree to join 4-H this year and use the market chickens as a 4-H project. The entry should consist of a cover page with name, address, phone number, age, name of 4-H group and a signed statement of parental approval. The essay should be a minimum of one page with no identifying names and include the following general topics:

- What goals the member will set for project?
- How will the animal be cared for?
- What housing facilities are available for the animal?

Up to 15 chicks will be awarded to the winner!
Essay entrants should pay for their birds and, if selected as the winner, will be reimbursed by the committee.

MEMBERS WILL GO OVER A FEW RULES. THEN EVERYONE WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THEIR POSITIONS TO SHADOW THE PREVIOUS WORKER, SO WE HAVE A SMOOTH TRANSITION.

2. HAIR SHOULD BE IN A PONY TAIL OR A HAT ON.
3. NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 16 CAN RUN THE BLENDERS PER HEALTH DEPARTMENT.
4. THE FLAVOR OF THE DAY WILL ONLY BE MADE THAT DAY NO OTHER DAY
5. THERE WILL BE NO SPECIAL REQUEST, FOR EXAMPLE DOUBLE CHOCOLATE OR EXTRA THICK ONLY USE RECIPES ON WALL.
6. THERE WILL BE SPONSOR CUPS FOR THE DAY. WHEN YOU HAND OUT MILKSHAKE: PUT LID ON, HAND A STRAW AND MAKE SURE SPONSOR IS FACING CUSTOMER.

10. ALL INGREDIENTS WILL BE DONE AS PUMPS THIS YEAR.
11. 9 KIDS AND ADVISERS AT A TIME WILL BE PLENTY. IF YOU HAVE A BIG CLUB, TRY AND SPLIT THEM UP.
