

Ashland County Tractor Certification Home Study Course

Welcome to the Tractor Certification Program! You will need an adult helper to work with you at home. Being a self-study course, it is up to you to conscientiously work through the manual and safety activities in a timely manner. We will have an optional, but recommended, meeting in early April to review materials, practice for the written test and review what the driving test will be like. The date and time will be announced in March.

The driving test will be held beginning at **9 a.m. on Saturday, April 18** at the Ashland County Fairgrounds. You need to complete your self-study by early April, so that we may administer the test and get you certified. The written test will be given at the Ashland County Extension Office **between April 7 and 16 by appointment.**

Below is a suggested outline for going through the student manual. You may work at your own pace but this serves as a helpful guideline to keep you on track.

Week 1 (Feb. 2) – review manual to get an idea of what will be covered. Complete Task Sheets 1.1. through 2.4. Write important dates on your calendar. It may be helpful to keep a small notebook with important information that you read or with questions that you have.

Week 2 (Feb. 9) – Complete Task Sheets 2.5 through 3.2

Week 3 (Feb. 16) – Complete Task Sheets 3.3 through 3.11

Week 4 (Feb. 23) – Complete Task Sheets 3.12 through 4.5

Week 5 (Mar. 1) – Complete Task Sheets 4.6 through 4.14

Week 6 (Mar. 8) – Complete Task Sheets 5.1 through 5.6

Week 7 (Mar. 15) – Complete Task Sheets 6.1 through 6.10

Week 8 (Mar. 22) – Review all Core Task Sheets

Week 9 (Mar. 29) – Continue Review

Week 10 and 11 (Apr. 5 and 12) – Take written test between April 7 and 16.
Take driving test on April 18

May – Certificates mailed for all those who successfully complete both sections of test.
