Advisor's: EIN Number/Tax Exempt Authorization Forms

Volunteers, **if you have been contacted** about obtaining a new EIN number for your club or committee, **please do so as soon as possible.**

After assigned a new EIN number, please make sure the Extension Office gets a copy of BOTH the IRS notice that a new EIN number was assigned and a completed TEA form. The TEA form is attached for your convenience. Please contact the Extension Office if you need assistance filing for a new EIN number. **Deadline is November 30, 2019**

If your club's organizational advisor has not been contacted via email about obtaining a new EIN number, Your EIN number is in good standing and you do NOT need to complete these steps.

The Extension Office will file the 990 tax forms for all clubs this year.
