- 3. a collection of prints illustrating one of the "activities" the exhibitor completed for the project, consisting of at least 5 and not more than 10 photographs, mounted at the discretion of the exhibitor.

**588:** Bring portfolio as described on page 40 of the project book.

**592:** Bring art project created in the project.
