RELEASE TIMES STAGGERED LIVESTOCK RELEASE TIMES

Please refer to Page 8 of Jr. Fair Book

1. Enter Livestock Gate #1 and Exit out Goat Gate.
2. Must have livestock trailer hauling actual animals (not truck for tack, gates, etc.)
3. If you have more than one species, (unless making separate trips) use latest release time.
4. Note: All market animals that are sold through sale ring are released immediately following their junior fair livestock sale (sheep, swine, goat, or beef).
Exception is market poultry and market rabbits (See Friday below)
