

First Year Rabbit Member Give-a-way Essay Contest

The Ashland County 4-H Rabbit Committee is sponsoring an essay contest for any First Year Ashland County 4-H/FFA member interested in taking a rabbit project. To be eligible, youth must agree to join 4-H or FFA this year and use the animal as a 4-H/FFA project and an Ashland County Junior Fair project. The entry should consist of the following cover page with name, address, phone number, age, name of 4-H group /FFA Chapter and include a signed statement of parental approval. The essay should be a minimum of one page with no identifying names, be titled "Why I Would Like to Win a Rabbit for a 4-H Project" and include the following general topics:

- What goals do you have for the project?
- How will the animal be cared for?
- What housing will be provided for the animal?

Members should list their first, second and third preferences of rabbit breeds. Choices may include Californian, New Zealand, Jersey Woolly, Fuzzy Lop, Holland Lop, Mini Rex and Dutch. The rabbits awarded will be based on availability.
